Our Vision

to transform lives for Jesus Christ

Simply put... we expect to change the world!

At Legacy, we want everyone to experience a life transforming relationship with Jesus Christ.

This is Legacy's mission – this is what we're called to do.

We want to bring the transforming influence of Jesus Christ into our world everyday - First to our own local community and then beyond. Our desire is to be a church that is outward focused toward our community and the world around us – a compassionate and caring church that demonstrates 'we're here to help.'

Since we moved into our leased facility on Soaring Gulls a little over two years ago, we have now more than doubled in size as more than 400 people now call Legacy their home.

Our plans are to add a third weekend service this Fall as we deal with crowded classrooms, offsite parking, limited main room space and no real place for the youth to call their own. We are also faced with the challenge of paying over \$20,000 a month to lease a facility that is less cost effective than building and developing our own campus and center for the community.

During the past two years, we have also seen our finances grow from \$380,000 in 2003 to \$490,000 in 2004 to a projected figure of just under \$600,000 for 2005.

So we do have some encouraging vital signs!

Providing the financial resources to underwrite the "Creating a Legacy" capital project that will assist in implementing our strategy.

Building our own campus and community center will:

- accommodate the growing number of people coming to Legacy
- allow the growth of the weekend services to accelerate
- provide the expanded space for our children's and youth ministries
- provide a center for the community for a greater impact
- increase our very limited parking
- solve our "rent vs. own" dilemma and give us a permanent place to call our own

Our BLM land journey

Legacy currently has 10 acres of reserved BLM land at the intersection of Grand Canyon and Lone Mountain - (with an adjacent 5 acres on first right of refusal.)

After a 4 year process, this has been fully approved by the BLM and is ready to go.

However, we also have an additional opportunity and we are currently in the process of amending this with the possibility of a larger BLM parcel of 20 acres located at Ann Road and the 215 beltway.
